2. Website Updates
 - a. Dahnish will make sure to organize the website

 - i. After decision has been made, we need to decide what the process related to UROP will be; a very simple two sentences for being denied, etc., and “you may reapply”
 - ii. The decision will be finalized after an appeal process; possibly not even have an appeal
 - b. Watched the video relating to the project
 - c. They have funding from UROP and departmental funds
 - d. Assign people to monitor projects
 - e. We need to make sure the TGIF logo is on it, wherever they have logo inclusion
 - f. Have marketing interns that enforce the contract
 - g. Logo inclusion is required in the contract
 - h. Only a piece of this project should be funded and before we release the money, we need to make sure the logo will be included
6. Review and Approve Growing and Extracting Biofuel from Algae
 - a. Have a discussion about research based projects
 - b. This project will need to include an educational component for exhibition to the rest of the student body
 - c. Transportation to the symposium will not be covered
7. Review and Approve Revamping Recycling Bins On Campus (6:15-Nancy Q&A)
 - a. Excessive publicity is unnecessary; t-shirts, buttons, smencils, water bottles, etc.
 - b. The cost per item is too high - \$85; total of \$15,300
 - c. By paying for the lids, they might not actually complete the criteria for Sierra Club and hence benefit UCI’s sustainable rating
 - d. The 140 CRV lids will not be changed; the information pertaining to changing the lids are unclear



- e. Marketing plan is not very focused
 - f. Specifics of the project such as a map of trash bins involved and will be reported via email
 - g. Concerns: break the numbers out - will this money maximally benefit thousands of students on campus?
 - h. Table the vote to next week
