## 2. Projects under review

- Student Institute for Sustainability Leadership 2016
  - Replied and said that they would be able to make a timeline
  - **Vote: 5 In Favor, 0 Opposed, 0 Abstain**
- The Living Zero Project
  - Bailey: Argued that bins needed to be mobile, but not actually necessary
  - Facilities management should cover those costs anyways
  - Krista: Trays seem like a reward, which should not be provided by TGIF
  - Zero waste stations are not provided by the facilities management, but may be something that should be provided by Student Housing
  - Vote on Zero waste stations, recycle bins, compost bins (to the Mesa Towers), vinyl shower hangers (stipulation of including low-flow information), signage: **5 In favor, 5 Opposed, 0 Abstain**
- The Sustainability Games
  - Application is relatively unchanged from the last one
  - Event responses are still vague
  - **Vote: 0 In favor, 5 Opposed, 0 Abstain**
